**Research Statement**

Richard Moon's research focuses on freedom of religion and freedom of expression and the structural aspects of constitutional rights protection in Canada. He is currently engaged in two larger writing projects:

The False Promise of Religious Neutrality – which considers the claim by the Canadian courts that the constitutional right to freedom of religion requires that the state remain neutral in religious matters and treat different belief systems in an equal or even-handed way.

Putting Faith in Hate: Religion as the Source and Subject of Hate Speech – which considers the intersection between religion and hate speech regulation.
