**Brief Biography**

Sam Reimer is Professor of Sociology at Crandall University in New Brunswick, Canada. His Ph.D. is from the University of Notre Dame in Indiana. He was visiting scholar at Baylor University (Texas) in 2005-6.

Sam is presently lead investigator of the Canadian Evangelical Churches Study, with included interviews of over 600 pastors in nearly 500 congregations in Canada. He also co-lead a team of researchers in a funded three-year study of Ecumenism in Canada. His research has also been funded by the Society for the Scientific Study of Religion, the Religious Research Association, the University of Notre Dame and Baylor University.

His recent publications include *Evangelicals and the Continental Divide* (McGill Queen's, 2003), "Class and congregations" (*Journal for the Scientific Study of Religion* 2007), "Lay cooperation in Canada" (*Journal of Ecumenical Studies*, 2004), "Higher education and theological liberalism" (*Sociology of Religion*, forthcoming), and many other articles and book chapters.
